Abstracts should contain no more than 600 words. Do not include references, charts or graphs.

Abstract should be written in English with Times New Roman, Font Size 12, 1.5 line spacing.

The abstract that is accepted, the paper may be assigned to the oral or poster session

Abstract format:

Heading:

- Title
- Name of authors (name of presenting author must be underlined)
- Institution Affiliation
- Address (City/Country)
- E-mail Address

Abstract content

- Introduction
- Objectives of the study
- Methodology (research design, study areas, sample size estimation, sampling technique, instrument, data collection, data analysis, ethical considerations)
- Result
- Conclusions and recommendations
